Hanze student trip Tanzania 2024

Dates: 17-27th of July 2024 (arrival and departure expected on the days before and after).

Location: Dar es Salaam, Tanzania.

Project:

- "Building a Business", collaboration between University of Dar es Salaam (UDSM) department of Engineering and UDSM Business School.

Travel: It is up to you how you get to Tanzania and from where. It is just important that you arrive on time for the summer school. Students from the school we are cooperating with, can assist with airport pick-up for example. Since not all students will depart from Amsterdam, all students will book their own flights and have total control over the costs of the flight and when they would like to return.

You also have the opportunity to travel before or after the summerschool and extend your visit with a safari or beach holiday to Zanzibar. From Dar es Salaam, you can have a 2-day safari to Mikumi national park or take the ferry to Zanzibar for \$35.

Accommodation: There is accommodation available on campus, however this has basic facilities. You may prefer to stay off campus, but then you are responsible for your own accommodation and transportation.

Safety: Tanzania is a safe country, but be careful. The streets are not always lit in the evenings, so especially in the evenings, we do not recommend to walk besides the road. If you wish to visit a restaurant nearby, you should use some mode of transportation (Uber or other type of taxi)

Buddy program: All students will be linked to Tanzanian students in advance. They can assist with arranging transportation from the airport.

Health care: Vaccinations may be advised by your doctor. This should be organized on time before you fly. Furthermore, it would be recommended to get prophylactic medication for malaria. To be sure on your personal situation, please check your doctor.

Program: You will be busy with working on your projects within the 10 days and spend most time during the time at the campus. Nevertheless, throughout the 10 days we have also cultural and social activities planned. Also, you are free to organize your own leisure time. Sundays are off.

Certificate: At the end of the student trip you will be awarded with a certificate of participation. Your final products and idea's will be presented to the companies involved and other stakeholders. You can discuss with your school if it is possible to receive EC credits for the student trip.

Total costs (estimation): between €1500 and €2000

This would include flights (upon your own choice), accommodation, food and transportation. Depending on your preferences and way of living this can deviate of course.

Fundraising: For the participation of the Tanzanian students, we ask each participant from Hanze to fundraise €250 each. This is to cover for meals and transportation for the students from the Tanzanian side.

Visa on arrival: Tanzania has a visa-on-arrival for most European passport holders (incl. Dutch). A tourist visa costs 50 US dollar. As a student, joining for the summer school, you are a tourist too. Since the exchange rate of EURO/US Dollar is almost the same, they accept €50 euro too. You can apply online in advance, to fast-track your arrival.

Money: In Tanzania the currency is Tanzanian Shilling (€1 equals TZS 2755. Although they accept Euro's/Dollars just as much, it is advised to carry Tanzanian Shilling with you and withdraw this from the ATM within the country. If you want to carry some cash with you, you can bring some Euro's with you to ensure you are not 100% cashless upon arrival.

Dress code: Tanzania has many different religions, but in general it is appropriate to cover up your knees and shoulders anytime. This is the general rule in Tanzania.
